A. For and in consideration of the granting of said permission the applicant agrees to the following instructions and provisions of the Washington City Ordinances 5-3-3 Section 18 with respect to the performances of work under this permit. This permit is valid for 6 months from the date of issuance at which time this permit will need to be renewed and an extension may be granted. Permit is not required if placed on private property and not in the City right of way.

1. The purpose of this permit is to exhaust all options of placing the dumpster on the lot. This permit is not guaranteed issuance; this will be on a site by site basis. A traffic control plan is required for each Dumpster Encroachment.
2. Erect and maintain around the Dumpster, Building materials and work area sufficient guards, signals, barricades, and lights. All traffic control shall be in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (M.U.T.C.D.) Traffic Control plan must be submitted to Washington City Public Works for approval with permit application.
3. As soon as work has been completed, restore the street to the same condition in which it existed prior to Dumpster / Building material permit. Including the removal of rock, dirt, rubbish, and all other materials from the street, which existed as a result of the Dumpster / Building Materials permit. Applicants will be responsible for maintaining the surface of the area from settlement and deterioration for a two year period after inspection.
4. All repairs will be made under the direction of a Washington City Representative.
5. Notify the Public Works Department at least 24 hours prior to patching asphalt or repairs to concrete indicating the time the repairs will be made before this permit can be closed out and completed.
6. No dumpsters shall impede the dedicated travel lane of any road or restrict any sidewalk for pedestrians.
7. Shall hold the City harmless from any and all claims, liability, demands or damages for any and all injury to persons or property arising in any manner out of or by reason of such Encroachment.
8. The Contractor shall be required to submit Erosion and Sediment Control BMP's to the City depending on the limits of the construction project.

B. The applicant shall file with the City a bond in the amount of \$5000.00 minimum, or as determined by the City, prior to starting the above mentioned encroachment. The said bond is conditioned upon the faithful performance of the owner or contractor in complying with the provision of this permit and Ordinance No. 5-3-3 Section 18 of the Washington City Code.

C. If any of the provisions of said bond or this permit is violated or not observed, Washington City may do all means necessary or proper to repair such street or way at the expense of the person making the encroachment.

D. Washington City may impose a \$1000.00 per day violation fee for non compliance.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read the instructions and provisions of this permit and Ordinance No. 5-3-3 section 18 of Washington City and agree to assume all duties and obligations therein.

DUMPSTER/BUILDING MATERIAL ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FEES

1. Fee for single dumpster / building material permit: \$ 500.00 per individual site. Permit will be valid for 6 months from the date of issuance.
2. Exception to the dumpster / building permit: A permit issued for the Dumpster / Building Materials does not give the developer, contractor, homeowner permission to encroach into the public right of way. Certain restrictions and requirements will apply. Fees applied unless determined by a Washington City Representative.
