Traffic Control plan must be submitted to Washington City Public Works for approval with permit application.					
3.	As soon as work has been completed, restore street to the same condition in which it existed prior to excavation. Including the removal of rock, dirt, rubbish, and all other materials from the street, which existed as a result of the excavation. Applicant will be responsible for maintaining the surface of the excavation area from settlement and deterioration for a two year period after inspection.					
4.	In the event excavation is through asphalt, concrete or any hard surface, make saw cuts perpendicular at the sides and ends from the surface for the full length and width of all excavation to the necessary depth.					
5.	Notify the Public Works Department at least 4 hours prior to back filling or patching asphalt indicating the time the trench is to be backfilled or patched.					
6.	Not to permit any excavation to remain open in any street for a period of more than 24 hours, nor to close any street or restrict without prior permission of the City, Police and Fire Department, and shall be notified 24 hours in advance of any planned street closure or detour.					
7.	Shall hold City harmless from any and all claims, liability, demands or damages for any and all injury to persons or property arising in any manner out of or by reason of such excavation.					
8.	All utility pothole locations within the encroachment that cannot be compacted do to physical size constraints shall first have the utility shaded with a 4" layer of sand and the remaining depth must be filled with a 1-bag slurry mix prior to the replacement of surface materials.

Encroachment Permit Fees

- 1. \$500.00 + \$2.00/sqft for new roads or newly resurfaced roads less than 3 year old. (Seamless Patch Required) a total resurfacing of the road may be required as determined by the City.
- 2. \$300.00 for directional boring of a new road or newly resurfaced road less than 3 years old, plus \$2.00/sqft for each pothole required for the purpose of relocating existing utilities. Maximum pothole size not to exceed 12 in x 12 in square. (Seamless Patch Required)as determined by the City.
- 3. $$250.^{00} + $1.^{50}$ /sqft for roads 3 to 5 years old (Seamless Patch Required)
- 4. $$150.^{00} + $1.^{00}/\text{sqft}$ for roads 5 to 10 years
- 5. $$125.^{00} + $1.^{00}$ /sqft for roads 10 to 15 years
- 6. $$100.^{00} + $1.^{00}$ /sqft for all roads older than 15 years
- 7. \$100.00 + \$1.00/sqft for all curb cuts and sidewalk.
- 8. Encroachment permit shall be required on all public Right of Ways and Easements.
- **9.** All permits are held to a 1 year warranty standard.
- Exception to the encroachment permit: A permit issued for the construction of a subdivision does not give the developer permission to encroach into the public right of way. Certain restrictions and requirements will apply. Fees applied unless determined by the city engineer.
